

**2020-21 ASSISTANCE LEAGUE OF EAST VALLEY SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR
STUDENTS OF EAST VALLEY INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY**

Assistance League of East Valley (ALEV) is a non-profit charitable organization committed to volunteer service in the community. Assistance League of East Valley works with community agencies and schools to provide help to both children and adults in need.

Our Scholarship Program is designed to provide assistance to graduating seniors of East Valley Institute of Technology, District #401, who have demonstrated financial need, scholarship and good citizenship.

Applicants awarded a scholarship will receive \$850 per semester for **four consecutive semesters** as long as the he/she complies with the recipient obligations. They are detailed on the next page.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Has financial need
- Has a 2.5 overall grade point average
- Plans to attend an accredited community college as a full-time student (12 credit hours)
- Is available for a personal interview with the ALEV Scholarship Committee
- Submits completed application by April 15

TO APPLY:

- Obtain application form from EVIT Administration Office or on-line
- Complete application form
- Attach a letter describing:

Any academic honors and awards you have received.

Your educational goals and future career plans

Your need for financial assistance

Your work experiences, extra-curricular activities you participated in during high school and/or volunteer activities you have done during your high school years

- Provide a current, **official** transcript of grades – both from EVIT and your high school
- Provide two letters of recommendation – one from an EVIT faculty member
- Provide a letter from parent, family member, or guardian confirming need
- Submit 1 copy of application forms, supporting documents to Jake Henson by April 15, 2020
- Retain a copy of all written materials for personal file. No application will be returned.

Jake Hansen will make completed applications available to the ALEV Scholarship Committee.

Upon receipt, the Assistance League of East Valley Scholarship Committee will carefully review each application.

Selected applicants will be contacted to set up an interview with ALEV Committee Representatives at the Main EVIT Campus.

NOTIFICATION OF AWARD:

- Applicants awarded a scholarship will be notified by phone by May 30, 2020
- Written confirmation of the award will follow

If you are awarded a scholarship, you will be assigned a mentor from the Assistance League East Valley Scholarship Committee. The Mentor will contact you for updates and is your cheerleader. She is there to assist you.

RECIPIENT OBLIGATIONS:

- Shall enroll as a full-time student at an accredited Arizona community college
- Shall initiate use of the scholarship immediately
- Shall maintain a 2.5 grade point average
- Shall provide an unofficial transcript of grades to the Scholarship Committee Mentor at the end of each semester no later than one week following the last day of the semester
- Shall furnish your Mentor with a copy of your class schedule for the upcoming semester three weeks prior to the first day of the next semester. These documents cannot be a screen shot but must be in a form that can be read
- Shall not fall below 12 credit hours
- Shall use scholarship for tuition, books, and fees only
- Shall notify Scholarship Committee Mentor of address/phone number changes
- Shall notify the Scholarship Committee Mentor immediately of failure to register/attend, for any reason, the institution of higher learning for which the scholarship was awarded
- Shall make repayment to Assistance League of East Valley for failure to complete an academic term.
